


Resource information:

Family Advocacy Program Victim Advocates (FAP).

If a victim of Domestic Violence is either active duty military or the dependent of a service member (any branch) there is an Advocacy program that will help the victim navigate the extensive, nationwide supportive services. Here are some facts:

- **24 Hr Victim Advocate Hotline 760-362-9837**
 - Victims can be live-in relationships (not necessary to be married), married to the service member, or dependent child. If unsure, call FAP anyway.
 - Advocates are available 24-hours and *will respond to any location* (even our offices)
 - Offender does not have to be military connected.
- Advocates will respond to domestic disturbances, emotional abuse, physical abuse, child abuse, child neglect, and sexual abuse with a familial connection***
 - *** if they have access to medical services on base then they qualify, if unsure call the advocate hotline, they will advise.
- Victims may access advocates and services even if they do not wish to file charges.
 - Restricted reporting means no investigation, but does provide supportive services.
 - Unrestricted reporting means XO or CO is contacted and an investigation is launched. The victim is provided supportive services.
 - Victim can choose to switch a restricted report to unrestricted report AT ANYTIME.
 - Incident can have occurred in the past, dependents have the right to supportive services at all times.
 - Advocates may help w/ civilian reporting as well.
- There are financial and social supports available (extensive), some life-long
 - Transitional Compensation: up to 36 months of standardized stipend (not dependent upon rank), 12 months Tri-Care, if an life-long injury occurred this program will continue to provide treatment for the injury life-long (for more information call FAP)
 - Chapter 15: essentially Spousal support for victims
 - Other programs are available as well, contact FAP for more information.
- Family Advocacy Program (FAP) is available on ALL installations across ALL military services

Victim Advocates are available to respond with law enforcement presence for victims of physical abuse or for non-offending parent. Victims and non-offending parents must agree to allow victim advocates to respond.
