ACTION ITEM

Board of Directors to review FY 23/24 Return of Organization Exempt Income Tax Form 990 and Schedule of Contributors Form 990:

CFO Anderson informed the Board that this is the annual tax return for the Foundation since the Foundation is a 501C3 and a separate organization. She went over the standard information and noted that on part one in the summary, we described the organization's mission and significant activities. Next we hit on the revenue and the expenses, note they are both for the prior year then ties into the net fund balance. The Foundation was set up on a cash basis, so the land proceeds that we received for the Foundation did not come in until after June 30th, which means, you will see them on next year's income tax return.

We had one expense this year for \$25.00, which is the amount it takes to file the charity trust with the state of California. CFO Anderson explained that because the Foundation and the District have the same Board of Directors, the IRS considers that the Foundation is related to the District because of the commonality of control.

Disclosure: Since this is a Foundation, and a 990, this means that this tax return is public, and any person can request a copy of this return and we would need to give them a copy.

CFO Anderson went on to explain the remaining sections and their meanings. The Foundation had a total revenue of \$1,990 for all contributions and \$26 in expenses (amount to file).
